### **Crucial Crew Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> June, Harrogate College, Hornbeam Park, Harrogate (10:00am – 12pm)**

Crucial Crew is a workshop run by the emergency services designed to teach children about hazards such as fire and health and safety risks that they may be faced with as they make the move to secondary school. Despite the subject matter the workshop is delivered in a fun and informative way and teaches the children how to stay safe as well as how to help others. All children should wear school uniform with sensible footwear and a suitable coat.
