### **Year 5/6 Residential**

#### **Low Mill Outdoor Centre, 8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019**

In Year 5 and 6 the children get the opportunity to take part in residential trips that enhance their learning as well as build self-confidence, team work and independence – essential skills which help prepare them for the transition to secondary education.

In April 2019, we will be taking the children to Low Mill Outdoor Centre near Leyburn for a 3 day, 2 night residential stay.

The full cost of the residential week is £171.20 and we have decided to launch the trip early to enable payments to be made in instalments over the next 5 months. We are asking for parents to **both consent and pay** for this trip via Parent Pay. A **£30** deposit is required to secure your child's place (payable by **25<sup>th</sup> October 2018**), thereafter the balance can be paid in full or in instalments; but we would ask that trip balance be paid in full by the **22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019**. Whilst we recognise that the cost of School Trips can be expensive, we believe it is important for all of our children to experience residential / out of school visits and would very much like to ensure that every child has the opportunity to take part. If you are experiencing financial difficulties please speak to either the school office or the Headteacher in confidence as there are partial bursaries / subsidies funded by both FoNR and a historical School Fund available for a limited number of trip places.

We will be holding a Parent's Information meeting in the near future to give you an overview of activities, advice on what your child needs to pack and answer any questions you may have.

Without exception, the children all enjoy their time on residential trips and it remains one of the highlights of the academic year for staff and pupils alike.

We look forward to accompanying your child to Low Mill.
